STABLE, CONSISTENT EMPLOYMENT

Over 72% of people with Intellectual and Developmental Disabilities in Illinois live with family caregivers. As caregivers continue to age and person-centered services become more popular, the desire for the personalized support, opportunity, and freedom experienced in Host Homes will increase. **The demand for this role will not change with the fluctuating economy and job market.**

SUPPLEMENTAL OR CAREER INCOME

Providers may continue working full time or part-time while earning supplemental income by making a difference from within their home. Provider receives a monthly reimbursement that is based on the individual's level of need and is tax-free. Contract offers referral bonuses, 20 hours monthly relief, 14 vacation days a year, and 24-hour support.

FREE TRAINING PROVIDED

No experience working with people with disabilities required! **EP!C provides all necessary training to potential providers** who pass a Health Care Workers Background check, have a high school diploma/GED, and have a valid Illinois driver's license. Training includes online DSP training, CPR/First Aid, and Medical Authorization.
